

Fun Flossing Art Project

Learn how to floss with this interactive art project

Goal(s) Addressed

- Student will learn important dental hygiene.
- Student will be able to use "pincer grasp" (thumb and pointer finger) to pick up items.
- Student will use hand eye coordination.



Materials Needed

- 1. Construction paper
- 2. Egg carton
- 3. White paint
- 4. Play-Doh (green and brown)
- 5. Floss and toothpicks
- 6. Glue

Layout

How should the room look? Where are the student's placed? When will this be taught?

• Students should be seated at a table with newspaper underneath.

Activity

Describe each step in detail. Include key vocabulary.

- 1. Cut a part of an egg carton and paint white.
- 2. Let dry, then glue down to the construction paper into the shape of a mouth.
- 3. After it has dried, put Play-Doh in between the egg cartons.
- 4. Use the floss and toothpicks to remove the Play-Doh.

Accommodations/Modifications/Adaptations

How can this lesson be adapted by kids with special needs?

- Students can watch parents first attempt the activity.
- Assist students on how to hold the floss.
