

# **Rainbow Art Project**

Learn your colors by making a rainbow in the clouds!

## Goal(s) Addressed

- ★ Student will match to sample using art materials
- ★ Student will follow a sequence of instructions
- ★ Student will engage in a multi-textural activity



### **Materials Needed**

- 1. Paper plate
- 2. Cotton balls
- 3. Liquid glue
- 4. Tweezers or clothespins
- 5. Strips of colored paper

## Layout

How should the room look? Where are the student's placed? When will this be taught?

- Best done while seated at a table but can also be completed on the floor
- Create a model beforehand for the student to reference during the activity OR complete the activity alongside your student so they can observe each step

### **Activity**

Describe each step in detail. Include key vocabulary.

- 1. Cut the paper plate in half OR into the shape of a cloud
- 2. Glue all of the colored strips along one edge of the "cloud"
- 3. Cover the rest of the "cloud" in glue
- 4. Use the tweezers/clothespin to pick up cotton balls and place them onto the cloud
- 5. Leave in a safe place to dry

## **Accommodations/Modifications/Adaptations**

How can this lesson be adapted by kids with special needs?

- Create a visual schedule to highlight each step
- Use colored markers to indicate where each color strip should be glued
- Instead of using tweezers/clothespin, allow student to use fingers instead
